NAIDOC WEEK

2020 NAIDOC Week was officially moved to this week due to Covid-19 community restrictions earlier in the year. As our school was operational at the time, we still managed to celebrate in the original NAIDOC week and enjoyed many activities including filming a combined video with Grafton High, Westlawn PS, Copmanhurst PS and Baryulgil PS. Later our school also collaborated with the Clarence Valley NAIDOC organisers and other schools in another video.

The theme of NAIDOC 2020 is 'Always was, always will be' and students and staff expressed what the theme meant to them personally. We are so proud of all our students and staff who participated in these videos and shared their opinions. Our Infants campus participated in NAIDOC rotational activities and also really enjoyed their Art and Language sessions with Miss Bek throughout the week. Our Primary students participated in a range of activities and special lessons with Uncle Dion.

Aboriginal Culture and history is embedded in our NSW curriculum and our students participate in weekly Bundjalung language lessons. Celebrations this term will vary for each class/grade. Last Friday our Year 3 students visited Yarrawarra and Sealy Lookout and enjoyed the cultural walk on Gumbaynggirr lands. This week Year 4 will be heading to Copmanhurst for a day of hands on learning including local Bundjalung stories and activities with Uncle Dion, kayaking, fishing and drawing. Classes will be focusing on the theme of NAIDOC in their Bundjalung weekly lessons and each class has organised various activities.

ADDITIONAL PROGRAMS

We often have parents ask what additional activities and programs are offered in the school. Below are <u>some</u> of the extra programs we offer for different grades or students.

- * MiniLit, MultiLit, & MacLit (intensive reading support for individuals or groups of up to 4)
- * Additional Teacher support in classrooms to support students with Literacy

* 2 Instructional Leader's working shoulder to shoulder with teachers in classrooms to support Literacy and Numeracy programs (predominantly with K-2 staff)

* 2 Learning and Support Teachers who work with students at 'point of need' with learning and behaviour needs. * The Brave Program (Program to assist with children who display anxious behaviours which is accessed via computer)

* Kelso's Choice (Resilience Program across K-6 teaching students clear and simple strategies to manage small problems and how to seek help for bigger problems)

* Positive Behaviour for Learning - Teache's explicit behaviour lessons each week based on the needs at the school * Cooking and Living skills group (5 week small group program. Students nominated through Learning and Support Team)

- * Social Skills groups (both campuses run numerous small group sessions each week)
- * Emotional regulation groups (small groups role play situations and appropriate responses)
- * Gross motor skills
- * Fine motor skills
- * Rock and Water Program (Students nominated through Learning and Support Team)
- * Bike Bus (every Friday)
- * Bike Mechanics Program (Lunch time 5-6 program currently)
- * Lunch time structured play inside called the 'Go room' infants (everyday) and Primary (Wed to Fri)
- * Lunchtime structured play outside (infants, Primary and SU)
- * Grade lunch time computer sessions (self nominate)
- * Bundjalung Language Lessons K-6
- * Band (grades 3-6 currently due to high numbers)
- * Dance (Junior and Senior ensembles as well as Junior and Senior Bundjalung Dance group)
- * Our library opens every lunch time and has lots on offer; books, games, computers
- * Sports equipment is available every lunch time for the students to borrow.
- * We currently have some students learning movie making and photography
- * In 2021, GPŚ Radio Station will run one lunch time per week (Primary agéd students will run this)
- * SRC
- * Breakfast Program Tuesday mornings (infants). This program will be expanded in 2021.
- * Gardening Programs

This isn't a list of every additional program, but this list will hopefully give parents an idea of some of the additional programs at Grafton PS.

YEAR 6 FAREWELL

This year our Year 6 Farewell will be held on Thursday 10th December in the newly renovated Grafton High School MPC. This will allow for all our Year 6 students to attend with school staff and still remain within the current Covid-19 guidelines. Students will enjoy a catered sit down meal, a chance to have photographs with their friends and a fun night celebrating the completion of their primary schooling. Due to Covid-19 safety precautions for the event, parents will not be able to enter the venue and we ask that all photographs be taken before presenting at the Grafton High MPC to avoid large gatherings outside the entry. All photographs taken on the night inside the MPC will be available in digital form for Year 6 students at nil cost.
