Student Leadership

With our school 'STAR' values, we believe that students need opportunities to flourish and reach their full potential academically, socially and emotionally. Providing opportunities for students to learn leadership skills and lead key initiatives across the school, which are student driven, are critical skillsets to learn and develop in their senior years of primary schooling. Our student leadership program provides students with opportunities to have input into decisions, voice concerns and make suggestions to improve our school, as well as becoming more aware and part of the wider community.

Leadership is integral to life-long learning. All students should have the opportunity to demonstrate and develop leadership skillsets. Student leadership roles at Grafton PS include School Captain, Vice Captain, Prefects, Sporting House Captains, Library Monitors and Student Representative Council.

Yr 5 students will deliver their speech in the hall whilst classes Years 3-5 will connect online and view the screening. Students will then vote online using a google form.

Year 2 Transition Week and Swim School

Dear Parents and Carers,

Next week, Week 8, will be an exciting week for our Year 2 students. Starting Monday 22nd November, Year 2 students and teachers will be spending the week at the Primary Campus as some transition for next year. The students will get to play in the "big playground", be able to visit the canteen when it is open and get their bearings amongst older students.

Year 2 will go to the Infants Campus as normal on Monday morning and will be walked across to the Primary Campus by their teachers. Pick up on Monday afternoon will be from the basketball courts directly across from the Infants. During the day on Monday, their teachers will be walking the children around the Primary Campus and pointing out different areas like where they line up in the morning (Tuesday-Friday) and where they might meet parents at home time, although the basketball court may be an option for the whole week but this is a family decision. Children who travel by bus will catch the bus home all week from the Primary Campus and are asked to get off at the Primary Campus from Tuesday to Friday.

Equally exciting for next week, is the fact that during the middle session between recess and lunch, Year 2 students will be attending a modified swim school for the week. Students are reminded to return their notes on or before Monday and remember to pack all their swimming gear. Students who have not returned their note will be walking to the pool with everyone else and will be supervised by their teachers as spectators.
