ICAS CHANGE IN DATES AND TECHNICAL ISSUES

Grafton Public School will again be participating in the world renowned ICAS Assessments this year. ICAS is designed to target students' higher-order thinking and problem-solving skills in English, Mathematics, Science, Writing, Spelling Bee and Digital Technologies. It is an optional assessment for students in Years 3-6.

Thanks to those parents who have already registered for the ICAS Assessments. Some parents may have experienced difficulties with registering their child online. ICAS have informed us there had been some technical issues but the registration was now back open and working well. ICAS have also informed all schools that due to the COVID situation and many schools remaining in the home learning phase that assessments will now be completed in September / October.

Any interested student can receive an information note from the office. **A new system will be in place this year. Families will need to pay directly to the ICAS website**.

Our school has signed up for the ICAS Assessments parent payment system (PPS) for English, Mathematics, Science, Writing, Spelling Bee and Digital Technologies. Through this system parents can pay for ICAS directly online while tests will still be held at our school.

<u>Year 1 Phonics Check In</u>

All Year I students will be completing the the Year I Phonics Screening Check in the coming weeks. Phonics is the relationship between letters and sounds and is vital in learning to read and write. This Screening Check is a short, quick assessment that tells teachers how your child is progressing in phonics. Your child will sit with the class teacher and will be asked to read 40 words aloud. These words include 20 real words and 20 nonsense words. The test normally takes a few minutes. If your child is struggling the teacher will stop the check. The check is carefully designed not to be stressful for your child. If you have any further questions please phone the school and ask to speak with Mrs Fletcher or Mrs Stephenson.

We will be having our annual Book Character Parade in **Term 3, Friday 20 August (Week 6)**. More information regarding this exciting event will be coming soon. Students in K-6 will have the opportunity to dress up as their favourite book character and parade

around to show off their designs!
