#### FLOOD FUNDING

Uniforms from our supplier, Lowes, can now be ordered by collecting an order form from either office. Once the form is returned, we will order on your behalf. There is a supply delay with certain items however we will get all orders to you as soon as possible.



U Design, situated in the old brewery complex in North Street, are the previous supplier of our uniforms. They have some residual stock remaining and are having a 1 week sale on all Grafton Public School uniforms at 20% off! **As this is old stock, there are limited sizes and styles available.** Please call out and see them if you need uniforms. The flood relief money can be used for these purchases as arrangements have been made with U Design.

Payments were credited to families at \$500 per child, however, how the parents/carers decide to spend that money is up to them. For example, a family got \$1000 as there are 2 students. If a parent decides to spend \$720 on one child's excursion, that is completely their decision, and the remainder will stay in credit for later use for either child.

#### SCHOOL HOURS

Just a reminder that the school is open at 8:15am each morning which is 30 minutes prior to the academic school day commencing and is in line with the NSW Department of Education guidelines. At 8:20am supervision commences on both campuses and this is when students should start entering the school grounds (up until the morning bell at 8:45am).



With the installation of the secure fencing on the K-2 Campus, the front gate in Mary Street will be unlocked at 8:15am by the Infants office staff when they commence duties. The front gate and playground will be supervised by staff on both campuses from 8:20am.

The school day concludes at **2:45pm** with the school office officially closing at 3:15pm. Staff are on duty to supervise the main gates until 3:00pm and then any students still onsite are required to wait with the bus duty teacher or wait in the office area. Contacts and then emergency contacts (if required) will be called if students are not collected from school.

If you require before or after school care, OOSH services are available from Grafton Super Centre at 295 Hoof Street and they will provide transport for the students to school in the morning and collect the students from school in the afternoon. OOSH Contact details are: 66589757 or 0466306220.

Our Primary canteen operates on **Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays only**. This canteen also services our Infants campus. Students on both campuses can place orders for recess and/or lunch by person or through the online ordering system 'quickcliq'. **If you would like to use 'flood funding', please complete a paper order and write 'flood payment'** on it as our online ordering system will not recognise this funding.

The app celebrates creativity with videos recorded in 15 seconds or less and shared across the Tik Tok community.

You have the ability to make cool, short videos-songs or short dialogues – that you can share with the world, and people can see them. Think MTV meets SNL meets karaoke meets Dubsmash meets American Idol meets Instagram.

#### Challenges

- 12+ content in the songs lyrics. Swearing and adult concepts in the provided music.
- Pornography, graphic content, suicide notes.
- Tik Tok users can search for other users to view or follow near their own location/city.
- User generated videos can be viewed and shared onto other social media and messaging apps increasing exposure.
- Bullying in comments.
- Users can publicise their messenger usernames or social media profiles on their Tik Tok profile.
- Many underage accounts with large amounts of followers.
- Easy for users to create multiple accounts and hide them from their parents.
- Fake Tik Tok apps on the app store that charge for download or offer followers.

#### How Do I Delete My Tik Tok Account?

- Open the Tik Tok app and login.
- Tap on the person icon at the lower right of your screen to open your profile.
- Click on the three dots located in the upper right corner.
- Click on 'Privacy and Settings'.

- A verified phone number is a requirement for removing your Tik Tok account.
- Scroll to the bottom of the page where it says 'Thinking about removing your account?' Tap it.
- O Tap 'Send Code'.
- Wait for the code to be sent.
- Enter the 4-digit code within 60 seconds
  - of it being sent to you. Then hit continue.
- Read over the implications of removing your account. Hit continue if you agree with the terms.
- Hit 'Delete Account'. You'll be logged out and your account will be deleted.

- Tap their name or photo.
