We would like to thank the parents and carers who took the time to complete and return the Strengths and Difficulties Questionnaire (SDQ) form that was distributed to all Kindergarten-Year 2 students in Term 1. The results of the SDQ form helps identify children who would benefit from being included in the Got It! group program.



The Got It! Group Program is running in both Term 3 & Term 4 at Grafton Public School. We would like to thank those parents who participated in Term 3. Parents of children in classes K/IEH, KB, KP, & ISW have been contacted for the group program commencing in Term 4.

Check In Assessments

During Term 4, students in Years 3 to 5 will participate in the Check-in assessment.

The Check-in assessment is a NSW Department of Education online literacy and numeracy assessment available to support schools to assess and monitor student learning.

The assessment can supplement existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs. Students with disability may receive the same level of support during the assessment they would normally receive in the classroom.

The assessment will be scheduled for our Year 3 to Year 5 students during Term 4, Week 1 and Week 2
All students complete a reading assessment and a numeracy assessment.


