On Thursday 23rd November to Friday 24th November, Russ the Story Bus, the Sydney Writers' Festival's beloved 'library-on-wheels' will be visiting

Grafton Public School.

Russ the Story Bus is a magical bus for primary school students that celebrates storytelling, reading and creativity, and encourages a lifelong love of books.

Russ the Story Bus is an entirely free literacy program funded by Sydney Writers' Festival's patrons and supporters bringing some of Australia's finest children's authors and illustrators into schools in Western Sydney.

Each student taking part will be invited on Russ to select a free book of their very own to keep, as well as take part in an interactive talk presented by a children's book author or illustrator. The author will share their love of books, discuss their craft and inspire children to think creatively about reading, writing and storytelling.

The author visiting Grafton Public School is Kelly Canby.

Kelly Canby is an award-winning, internationally published, illustrator and author of over two dozen books for children. Kelly was born in London, England, but has lived in Australia since the age of three, which is probably around the same age she started playing with pencils and crayons, and it was probably only a few years after that that she decided playing with pencils and crayons was something she wanted to do for the rest of her life.


