

YFAR 6 'STAR' AWARD - Revised

This award is presented to any Year 6 student who demonstrates consistent commitment to all spheres of school life during the Year 6 school year.

* All Year 6 students are eligible for this award if all necessary criteria are met.

Students must comply with the outlined criteria in each of the following areas: ACADEMIC, BEHAVIOUR, SPORT, COMMUNITY SERVICE and SCHOOL SERVICE.

ACADEMIC (ALL criteria to be met)

- Homework: Homework must be submitted each week each term. Students are permitted to miss ONCE only within the term. A parent/carer note is required if this occurs.
- Work assignments: to be submitted on time. No extensions allowed excepting extenuating circumstances eq, family crisis, extended family holiday etc.....
- Library: Borrow from the Library with a minimum 80% rate per term eg, 8 times in a 10 week term.



BEHAVIOUR (ALL criteria to be met)

- Positive behaviour record: (not more than ONE Detention per semester, No Levels
 - No Suspensions) over the duration of the school year.
- Full school uniform, including plain black shoes and school hat: to be worn consistently (N.B. Please refer to the GPS Uniform Policy guidelines)

SPORT (ALL criteria to be met)

Attendance at:

- Annual Athletics and Swimming Carnivals
- Participation in the School Cross Country

COMMUNITY SERVICE (ALL criteria to be met)

Representation of Grafton Public School at:

- ANZAC Day Service
- Jacaranda March of Youth

SCHOOL SERVICE (AT LEAST TWO criteria to be met)

Participation in:

- School Band
- Special Ed. Buddies
- All Grades School Choir
- Infants Play Buddies

- Drama Club
- Year 2 Play Organised Games Buddies
- Aboriginal Dance Group
- Year 6 assigned roles, including daily flags
- Photography Club
- Support and participation in school fundraising
- Green Team
- Kilometre Club (both sessions each week, when at school)

All students meeting the above listed criteria will be presented with a Grafton Public School STAR Award i.e. School medal at Presentation Day 2013.
